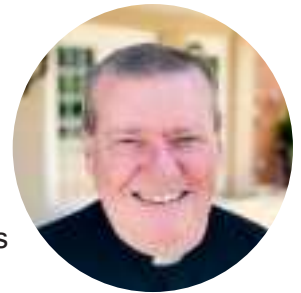

Dear Friends,

As we reach the end of Respect Life Month, I would like to take the opportunity to recognize Mike and Marybeth Schoenwald, the heads of our parish Respect Life Committee. They do a tremendous job keeping informed on issues regarding protecting human life from various threats: euthanasia, assisted suicide and abortion. As these evils become more of a reality in our culture, it is more important than ever that Christians witness to the truth.



Last month, in speaking of abortion, Pope Francis said, "Abortion is more than a problem – abortion is homicide. "Whoever has an abortion kills. It is a human life. This human life must be respected – this principle is so clear."
