

#### **Relocation of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion**

All communion ministers will serve from the front of the church. Christ is the bridegroom of the Church and we, the Church, are the Bride of Christ. It is important that as the Church, we come to the altar to receive and be made one with Christ. It is there, at the altar of sacrifice, where heaven and earth meet and we partake in the Eucharist, the source and summit of our faith. For those who are physically unable to come to the front to receive, our ushers will assist in making sure that a communion minister comes directly to you. If this applies to you, please make an usher aware prior to Mass.

#### **Arrival of New Missal/Hymnal**

A new missal/hymnal has been added into the pews alongside our current Gather hymnal. The Source & Summit Missal contains complete readings from the Lectionary for every Sunday, Solemnity, and holy day of obligation, reading synopses for Daily Mass, and antiphons from the English translation of the Roman Missal and Graduale Romanum. The core repertoire of the Source & Summit Missal are time-tested and theologically reliable English hymns and a collection of hymns from the Liturgy of the Hours set to familiar tunes. We are excited to introduce this new resource to our parish! We will continue to utilize our Gather hymnal as well and maintain our robust contemporary music catalogue.





#### MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT

In a video message last month, Pope Francis invites participants in the IV World Meeting of Popular Movements to dream and work together through solidarity and subsidiarity in order to build a better society and emerge better from the Covid-19 pandemic. The pandemic has laid bare the social inequalities that afflict our peoples.

We have stopped questioning the scourge of the food crisis. This year twenty million more people have been dragged down to **extreme levels of food insecurity**. But this does not make the news. It does not generate empathy.

We also experience resistance to the changes we need and long for, many forms of resistance that run deep, that are rooted beyond our strength and decisions. They are what the Social Teaching of the Church calls structures of sin; I ask:

- o all the great pharmaceutical laboratories to **release the patents**. Make a gesture of humanity and allow every country, every people, every human being, to have access to the vaccines.
- the great extractive industries -- mining, oil, forestry, real estate, agribusiness -- to stop destroying forests, wetlands and mountains, to stop polluting rivers and seas, to stop poisoning food and people.
- financial groups and international credit institutions to allow poor countries to assure "the basic needs of their people" and to cancel those debts that so often are contracted against the interests of those same peoples.
- the great food corporations to stop imposing monopolistic systems of production and distribution that inflate prices and end up withholding bread from the hungry.
- o arms manufacturers and dealers to completely **stop their activity, because it foments violence and war**, it contributes to those awful geopolitical games which cost millions of lives displaced and millions dead.
- the technology giants to stop exploiting human weakness, people's vulnerability, for the sake of profits without caring about the spread of hate speech, grooming, fake news, conspiracy theories, and political manipulation.
- o the media to **stop the logic of post-truth**, disinformation, defamation, slander and the unhealthy attraction to dirt and scandal, and to contribute to human fraternity and empathy with those who are most deeply damaged.
- o governments in general, politicians of all parties, to represent their people and to work for the common good.

#### WEEKLY INTENTIONS

**CHANGES COMING TO MASS INTENTIONS:** On January 1, 2022 we will be making changes to our mass intentions. Four take-aways to keep in mind:

- 1.) Intentions don't have to be for the deceased; you can also ask that a mass be offered up in thanksgiving for a birthday, anniversary or other worthy causes. Please do indicate if it is for someone deceased.
- 2.) No more than four intentions will be remembered at Sunday masses. Sunday intentions will be assigned to a specific mass as requested.
- 3.) Mass intentions are a free-will donation, but it's customary to donate \$10/mass.
- 4.) Request an intention at least two weeks ahead of time for a specific date.


**Marriage** - At least six months prior to your wedding date please contact the Parish Office about setting a date.
