#### Dear Friends,

We are treated today to St. Paul's beautiful words written to the Church of Philippi: "I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work in you will continue to complete it until the day of Christ Jesus." Phil 1:6.

The day of Christ Jesus refers to the end times – the Second Coming of Jesus at the end of the world, when He will gather his righteous ones, and present them to His Father. Paul's desire for the Philippians – and for us - is, "that you may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ."

What is righteousness? The simplest understanding of the word is being in right relationship with God. This Advent season, in which we look forward to the second coming of the Lord, is a graced time to prepare for this.

Here at our parish we offer some additional opportunities for encountering Jesus: daily Masses added at noon each day Monday through Friday, confessions at our regular times, and in addition, the multi-parish confessions listed elsewhere in the bulletin, and perpetual adoration in our beautiful chapel. Please take advantage of these opportunities to grow in right relationship with our loving God.




