Dear Friends,

Christmas has just passed, and we are already moving into the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. The famous story of the wedding at Cana is the first of his "signs," or miracles, by which he reveals his identity to his followers. The "Book of Signs" is found within the first twelve chapters of this Gospel

The six other signs are healing the royal official's son, healing the paralytic at Bethesda, feeding the 5000, walking on water, healing the man blind from birth, and the raising of Lazarus.

These powerful miracles reveal to the people the great authority and power that Jesus exercises, and his great love for those who are suffering or in need. The life of Jesus, and in particular his death and resurrection, have dramatically changed the history of the world. There is a beautiful alternative to

the worldly values of power, pleasure and wealth in Christ's values of self-sacrifice, mercy, and kindness. Flowing out of Jesus' pierced heart of love, we are empowered to live in that love by the Holy Spirit's abundant gifts.

Mary has a pivotal part in the wedding at Cana. It is she, called "woman" by Jesus, who brought the God-man into the world — she is the conduit of God's grace to mankind. Eve, the first woman, and her husband Adam, brought sin and death into the world. God will make all things new in Jesus Christ.



Candlemas Day

Sunday, February 2

How will we celebrate?

The priests will bless candles at all the weekend Masses on February 1 and 2 this year. You are encouraged to bring candles from home to be blessed.

Why on February 2?

February 2 is exactly forty days after December 25, the nativity of Jesus. Jewish law (Ex 13:2, 12) dictated that Jesus, as the firstborn, be consecrated to God. This was done by the parents as they presented their Son in the Temple. The Catholic church celebrates February 2nd as the feast of the Presentation of the Lord.

In the Gospel for February 2, Luke highlights the role of Simeon and Anna, two righteous Jews who recognized Jesus as the long-awaited Messiah and praised God for being able to see and experience such a marvel in their lifetimes.

What does this have to do with candles?

Simeon's prayer concerning the special role of Jesus states that Jesus is "a light for revelation to the Gentiles." This phrase eventually originated the custom of blessing candles on this day which were to be used in the ceremonies, rituals, and processions throughout the church year.

Thus February 2 is known as Candlemas Day. This day is indeed a rich feast to be savored. We hope you'll join us!




