Dear Friends,

Some Scripture scholars have commented that the beloved parable of the Prodigal Son ought better be named the parable of the Prodigal Father.

Merriam Webster defines the word prodigal as: characterized by profuse or wasteful expenditure: lavish; yielding abundantly: luxuriant; one who spends or gives lavishly and foolishly.

The son in this parable can clearly defined in this way. He burned through his inheritance foolishly and wastefully, spending his father's hard-earned fortune lavishly and luxuriously until there was nothing left. He did this only after cruelly insulting his father, saying the equivalent of "I wish you were dead" and demanding what was not his – his future inheritance.

But in what was an even more prodigal act, the father, foolishly it may seem to us, lavishly and generously pours out his forgiveness on his wayward son. This parable is about God the Father's profuse outpouring of love and forgiveness and restoration to right relationship.

To some, this may seem foolish and wasteful. For sure, it is undeserved. But this is a loving Father's outpouring of love and his delight in the return of his son. The parable ends with the Father's words: "But now we must celebrate and rejoice,

because your brother was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found." Luke 15:32






Experience a powerful live performance of Christ's Passion




